Informational Survey

The Bay Area Asian Coalition Against the War (BAACAW) was formed out of a need for Asians in America to Build a broad coalition to end the war in Vietnam. Our two principles of unity are: 1) to oppose the Nixon Administration, while not endorsing any other candidate or electoral politics; and 2) to support the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam's 7-Point Peace Proposal of July 1971. Activities based on our two principles include: publishing educational materials, teach-ins, study groups, mass demonstrations and propaganda brigades.

Regional participation on a local organizing basis encompasses areas such as the Peninsula - San Jose, Oakland, Berkeley, San Francisco - Japanese community, San Francisco - Chinatown/Manilatown community and the Student community.

At this particular time the Student Regional of the Bay Area Asian Coalition Against the War is undergoing an expansion program. People are encouraged to attend a mass informational meeting for the Student Regional to be held on July 17, 1972, 7:30 p.m., Christ United Church, 1500 Post Street, San Francisco.
