Recently, because of the economic crises, which seem to be hitting everything, food prices have been skyrocketing. We think decent and inexpensive food is a fundamental human right. To that end we have begun a Food Coop with which we hope will serve 2 purposes:

- 1) To enable people of different Asian Communities to work, share and learn together around something basic and concrete.
- 2) To begin to fight against high food prices by working together and buying wholesale.
