The National Coaltion for Redress/Reparations (NCRR) is a grassroots organization that was founded in 1980. With chapters in various cities, NCRR has been active in the campaign for redress in seeking to gain justice for Japanese Americans who were incarcerated during World War II. NCRR recently organized a 120 member lobbying delegation that visited Washington D.C. to seek support for passage of H.R. 442. Future plans include mobilizing community support for Presidential approval of redress legislation and organizing a major "Day of Remembrance" event in February, 1988, to commemorate the anniversary of the signing of Executive Order 9066 by President Roosevelt.
